Chairman Michael Bolden called the meeting to order at 1:30 PM and welcomed everyone. The meeting was held via teleconference. Ms. Vicki Helfrich, Executive Officer, employed the use of roll call to check attendance and to ensure that a quorum was attained. Chairman Bolden called for the review and approval of the June 4, 2020 minutes. Chairman Bolden called for a motion to accept the minutes. Commissioner Audrey McAfee made a motion to accept the minutes, seconded by Commissioner Donald Loper. Chairman Bolden called for unanimous consent, with no objection heard, the motion carried.

Ms. Helfrich provided the MSWIN Status Update for the month of June 2020. She reported information on MOUs and renewals, special event talk groups assigned, activities staff participated in during June, the number of users, and the number of push-to-talks. Ms. Helfrich also reported staff continues to work with MEMA and other state agencies on communications for COVID-19; work with AT&T/FirstNet on tower leases to locate equipment on MSWIN towers; and has completed all MSWIN preventive maintenance (system and facilities) for FY2020.

Ms. Helfrich provided an update on WCC contract status. The WCC has three contracts in the renewal process – Butler Snow, Cindy Crocker, and Renea Walton. These contracts are renewed on an annual basis. The contract with SBA for tower leases has been finalized.

Bill Buffington, Technical Director, provided the MSWIN Project Status Update for the month of June 2020. Mr. Buffington reported that the BTOP work is almost complete with acceptance testing being conducted over the past weekend with the completion of the microwave additions in the coastal counties. Additionally, the Stennis site is near completion as radio equipment is on site and the tower crew is scheduled to hang antennas in July. Mr. Buffington also reported that the Canton site tower construction is complete, radio equipment is on site, utility power has been finalized with Entergy, and microwave equipment will soon be added.

Ms. Helfrich reported on the Legislative Budget status. The WCC's FY2021 appropriation bill, Senate Bill 2972, has been approved by the Legislature for \$10,107.880 with 10 positions. This is approximately a 5% reduction from the FY2020 appropriation. The WCC will need to request deficit funding for FY2021.

Chairman Bolden called for the report of the Procurement Review Committee. Commissioner Perry Waggener stated there was nothing to report.

Chairman Bolden called for the report of the Governance/Interoperability Committee. Vice-Chairman Tom Lariviere stated there was nothing to report. Vice-Chairman Lariviere then asked Mr. Dent Guynes to report on the testing of the MS-FOG (Field Operation Guide) application. Mr. Guynes reported that the testing of

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the application has been completed. All parties involved were very pleased with the process and feedback has been incorporated into the final stages of the development process. The MS-FOG application will be available in the Google and Apple stores by mid-July.

Chairman Bolden called for the report of the Emerging Technologies Committee. Vice-Chairman Lariviere stated there was nothing to report.

Chairman Bolden called for the approval of expenditures. Commissioner Holly Savorgnan provided the financial reports for June 2020, including general funds, grant funds, and program income as provided on the WCC Detail of Monthly Expenses and the WCC Activity Reports. Commissioner Savorgnan pointed out that Program Revenue Income has been added to the financial report. Chairman Bolden called for any discussion. With no further discussion, Commissioner Loper motioned to accept the report, seconded by Commissioner Jenny Williams. Chairman Bolden called for unanimous consent, with no objection heard, the motion carried.

Chairman Bolden called for the report of Other Business. Ms. Helfrich presented the FY2022 Budget Request. The request is for \$10,735,802.00 which is a slight increase of \$95,928.00 over the budget request for FY2021. This request includes \$825,174.00 in salaries for 10 (ten) PINS, \$10,000.00 for travel, \$9,866,028.00 for Contractual Services, \$24,600.00 for commodities, \$10,000.00 for Equipment, and \$0 for vehicles. The change to the budget request includes a \$120,882.00 increase in the Contractual Services budget category (due to ground lease/tower lease 5-year renewals) and a \$25,000.00 decrease in the Vehicle budget category as the agency is not requesting a vehicle. Chairman Bolden called for any discussion. With no further discussion, Commissioner Huff motioned to approve the WCC's FY2022 Budget Request for \$10,735,802.00 and 10 PINS, seconded by Commissioner Steve Gray. Chairman Bolden called for unanimous consent, with no objection heard, the motion carried.

With no further business to discuss, Chairman Bolden announced the next monthly meeting will be held at 1:30 PM, on August 6, 2020, in either room 145 of the Woolfolk Building at 501 North West Street, Jackson, MS or by teleconference. Chairman Bolden then entertained a motion to adjourn the meeting. Commissioner Loper motioned to adjourn. Chairman Bolden called for unanimous consent, with no objection heard, the motion carried.
