Chairman Davis called for the review of and a motion to approve the August 4, 2022, minutes. Commissioner Donald Loper made a motion to approve the minutes, seconded by Commissioner Doug Mann. Chairman Davis called for the report of the Procurement Committee. Commissioner Donald Loper presented two procurement requests to the commission.
